**Dan Grading:** Students wishing to Dan Grade must attend a minimum of **2 days** training. The costings of the Dan Grading will be advised on receipt of the application – ensure a current e-mail address is supplied with the application. Payment can then be made on the door at the course. Please come 30minutes before each class if booking in for the Grading. **Payments for the Dan Grading Exams are in cash and US Dollars Only.**

**Qualification Exam:** All people wishing to take the **Refereeing and/ or Instructors Qualification Exam** must pre-register for the exam. The exam will consist of a practical and a written exam. Knowledge of the JKA Tournament rules and Instructors Manual are essential for all people wishing to take the exams.
